

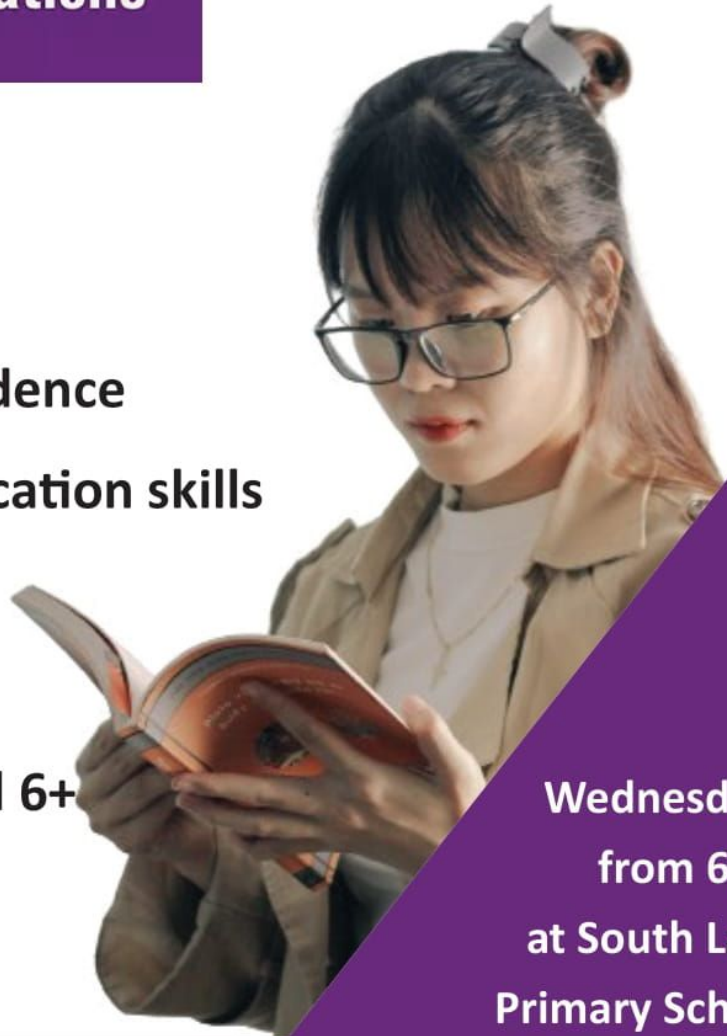

## SYNOPSIS

---

Be careful what you wish for as Stephen Sondheim's and James Lapine's cockeyed fairytale comes to life in this adaptation of their ground-breaking, Tony Award-winning musical. Into the Woods Jr features all of your favourite characters – Cinderella, Little Red Riding Hood, Jack (and his beanstalk) and the Witch in this lyrically rich retelling of classic Brothers Grimm fables.

The musical centres on a baker and his wife, who wish to have a child; Cinderella, who wishes to attend the King's festival; and Jack, who wishes his cow would give milk. When the baker and his wife learn that they cannot have a child because of a witch's curse, the two set off on a journey to break the curse and wind up changed forever.

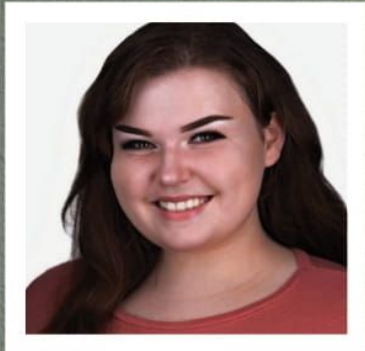

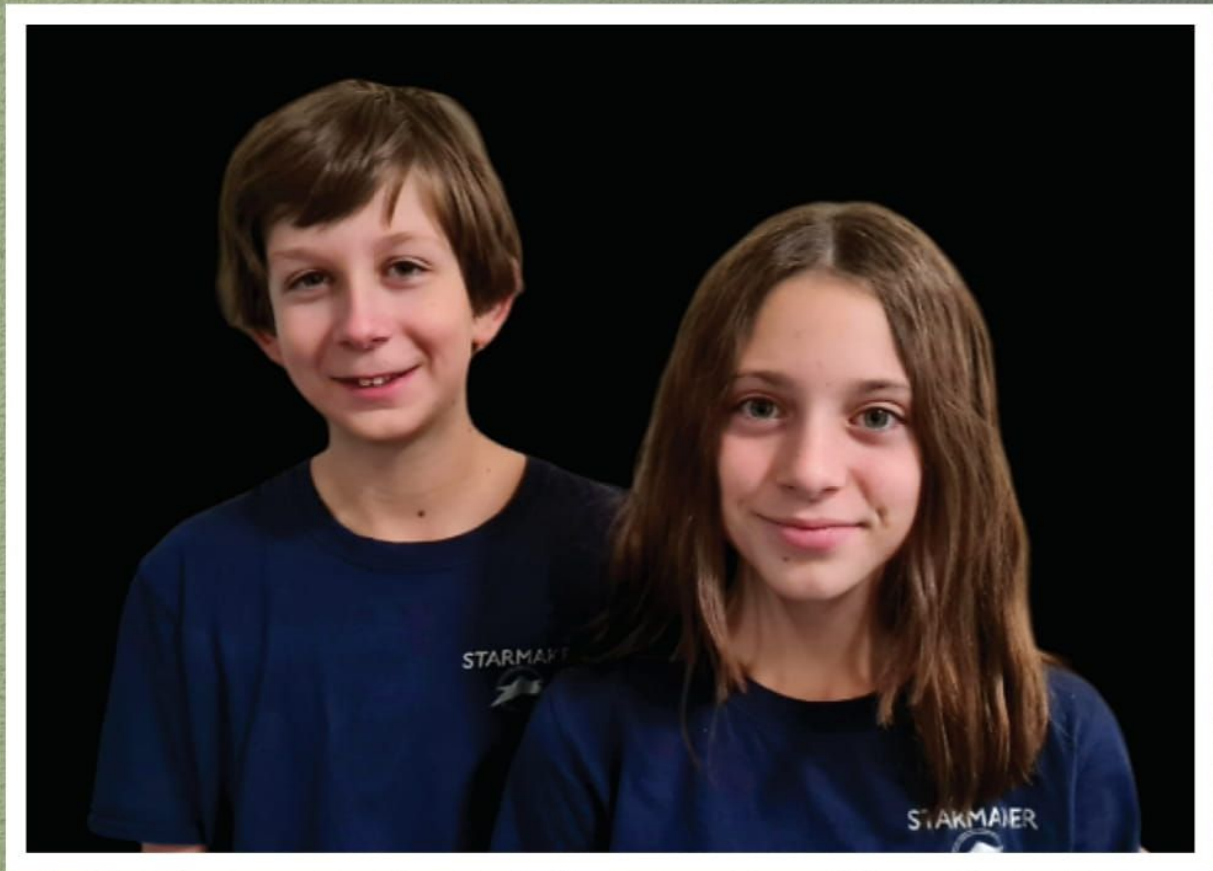
### CHARLIE KENDALL

# OUR HISTORY

---

In February 1988, a team of people sat in a lounge, dreaming of starting a theatre company for young people. A dream of giving them the opportunity to work and socialise in a healthy environment and to provide training in all aspects of theatre and the performing arts. With professional directors, musicians, choreographers and technicians, youngsters can gain confidence and experience in this field with the addition of valuable guidance, assistance in all social and career matters related to the entertainment industry and finally to provide top quality entertainment for the community with happy and enthusiastic young people.

Starmaker is not only providing all these things, but much more. We continue to be inventive and push the barriers of the Company, to give our members exceptional experience of the performing arts and to develop life skills like confidence and team work. With two or three productions each year, we offer our members the opportunity to enjoy working in all genres of the performing arts. We have performed at The Hexagon in Reading, The Kenton Theatre in Henley, The Wilde Theatre in Bracknell, The Fulcrum in Slough, The Corn Exchange in Newbury, The Desborough Hall, Pearce Suite in Maidenhead, The Oakwood Theatre in Woodley, The Whitty Theatre in Wokingham, Wokingham Theatre and Shinfield Theatre as well as The Royal Albert Hall in London. Many of our members have gone on to be professionally trained in performing arts colleges

all over the country and many are now working professionally in Theatre, Film and Television. We're especially proud that in recent years several junior members have been cast in professional theatre productions and feature films. Others apply the skills they learn at Starmaker to succeed in other fields.

During our 34 years, we have performed well over 120 shows. Starmaker is very proud of the fact that it has helped other charitable organisations in raising funds, and supporting them in their aims. Starmaker Theatre Company is itself a registered charity and is not part of a major franchise. Starmaker hopes to be able to continue to operate for many years to come and if you are able to offer help in any way, it would be gratefully received as we do not receive any public funding and have to survive purely on our own resources.

The help can come in many ways, including helping us to increase our profile, working with us on one of our many voluntary teams, financially or just by coming and supporting our members in productions. Whatever help you can give, is very much appreciated. After 34 years (and a long break due to covid), Starmaker is rebuilding our company for future generations, and we are delighted to return to The Alan Cornish Theatre (named after one of our founders).
